



NEPGA Massachusetts Chapter Player of the Year Points System

The MA chapter Professional who gathers the most points at the close of the tournament season shall win the MA Chapter Player of the Year honor.

You can only earn tournament POY points as an apprentice or member that is employed within the MA Chapter at the time of that tournament.

For example, if you moved into the MA Chapter mid-year from another NEPGA Chapter, you couldn't retro-act points that would've been earned had you been a MA Chapter member at the time of that event.

●Stroke Play events will base points on an inverse scale awarding 1 point to last place.

- Individual Stroke Play Events & Stablefords: Total number (#) of Professionals in the Field will be the number (#) of points awarded to 1st place.
- Chapter Championship: Double the Points of an Individual Stroke Play
- Pro-Pro's: Total number (#) of Teams in the Field will be the number of points awarded to first place. Players on the team will each receive ½ of the team points.
 - Last place in a Pro-Pro means each players receives ½ point
 - 1st place, 24 teams, means 12 points for each player
- Points are only awarded to Overall tournament finish
 - Winning a 6-hole segment of the 6-6-6- will not receive points

-Point averaging shall be taken into account for all ties (similar to purse splits)

●Match play:

- Players who qualify for Match Play will receive ¼ of the number (#) of qualifying spots with each win worth 4 points assuming single elimination brackets
 - Win sweet 16 match, elite 8, semi-final and finals match → earn 20 total points
- No qualifier -> No qualifying points.
