The Teaching Professional will provide instruction including private golf lessons, group clinics, junior camps and assist with the marketing of new and existing player development programs to the facility's customers and to the community.

Position Requirements

- Maintain PGA of America membership in good standing in an active classification
- Actively pursue PGA membership (if a PGA Associate) in a timely manner through the PGA Professional Golf Management (PGA PGM) program
- Fundamental knowledge of the game of golf, rules of golf, and current on teaching methods and technology
- Strong organizational, planning and prioritization skills
- Self-motivated with desire to promote and market
- Service and customer focused attitude
- Experienced in written and oral business communications
- Maintain and promote a positive professional image within the community

Specific Responsibilities

- Implement and execute all facets of the golf instruction program
- Research and incorporate state of the art teaching methods
- Conduct private individual and group lessons
- Develop a beginner's golf program
- Develop, organize, and implement a junior program; camps, clinics, summer program and individual lessons
- Development of programming designed to attract new and existing golfers
- Report on instruction program data on a regular basis
- Custom club fitting

Compensation

- Teaching Professional keeps 100% of lesson income
- Club fitting sales 50/50 profit split
- Position is seasonal, start date ASAP until November
- As an independent contractor you make your own schedule, collect your own fees and schedule lessons, clinics and camps as your time allows
- Sagamore Spring Golf Club requires signed contract for the remainder of the season. A \$1500 fee will be required on a monthly basis
