

Maine Chapter Scholarship

Eligibility and Requirements:

- A Student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.2 (un-weighted GPA based on a 4.0 scale) or higher finishing high school or in college to be eligible to apply.
- Applicants must be children, step-children or grandchildren of a Maine PGA professional in good standing. Children, step-children or grandchildren of Class "F" PGA members are not eligible.
- The Maine PGA Scholarship is for the first four years of college only. Students MUST re-apply each year. (Graduate studies or fifth year undergraduate studies are not eligible.)
- Applicants who are high school seniors must have or plan to complete high school during the current year of applying. Applicants must also be enrolled or plan to enroll as a full-time student at an accredited college or university. A full-time student is defined as one who is taking 12 or more hours in a course of study leading to an associates or bachelor's degree.
- Applicants should ensure they are eligible for the scholarship per NCAA Rules and Guidelines.
- The involvement and achievement of the PGA Member is not part of the selection criteria.
- The Maine PGA Scholarship Program is designed to award scholarships. The amount and number of scholarships is determined by the committee based on available funds and may vary from year to year. Scholarships are awarded at the discretion of the Maine PGA Scholarship Committee.

All applications must be submitted by the end of the day – June 30, 2023
