His most recent victory and most prized is the First Parent/Child Championship victory with his son Sean. Finally, four runner-up finishes in the Section Championship, a runner-up in the Mass Open, New Hampshire Open and New England Open.

Frank has served as a past tournament chairman for the Massachusetts PGA Chapter and multiple years on the NEPGA Tournament Committee. His awards include two Massachusetts Chapter PGA Golf Professional of the Year, one Massachusetts Chapter PGA Merchandiser of the Year, and the 2006 Skip Wogan Award Winner of the NEPGA. While working at Kernwood for over 30 years, the Head Professional has been a crusader on the TaylorMade National Advisory Staff for over 25 years.

In closing, the pillars of his career at Kernwood have been centered around family, dedication, and loyalty. His commitment to these pillars for over 30 years has pervaded his career at Kernwood Country Club, where he raised his family with wife Jennifer, retained three outstanding Assistant Professionals, Steve Bramlett PGA, Keith Bursey and Craig Pitman, for over 25 years, and served four generations of membership that felt like family.
