

Bill Flynn Family Scholarship



Bill Flynn was a NEPGA Professional and Hall of Fame Inductee, who overcame a partially paralyzed right arm from birth to become an icon in the North Shore and New England golf circles. He was the first Head Golf Professional at Thomson Country Club, where he served in that role from 1961-1986. An accomplished player, Mr. Flynn won the 1959 Vermont Open, the 1963 Massachusetts Open, and the 1968 New England PGA Section Championship. Mr. Flynn also served on the executive committee of the New England PGA for seven years, then assumed the duties of secretary-treasurer for three years followed by his presidency from 1973-1976. During his career, he also served as Vice-President of the PGA of America.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be a current NEPGA Junior Tour member (2025)
- Must have graduated high school during the spring of 2024
- Must have been a member of the NEPGA Jr. Tour for 3+ years (current year may be included)
- Must be enrolled/attend an accredited 2 year or 4 year College or University in the fall of 2025
- Must have outstanding personal character, sportsmanship, and leadership qualities

Required Documents:

- Number of Years junior has been a member of the NEPGA Junior TOUR
- Letter of Recommendation
- School Activities (golf/other sports/clubs/etc)
- Essay of 500 words or less on the reason junior should be awarded the scholarship
- Community Service (Non-Golf Activities)
- GPA (Must include/attach final 2024 High School Transcript)
- Copy of college/university acceptance letter
