MESSAGE FROM YOUR PGA EMPLOYMENT CONSULTANT



Now is the time for Performance Evaluations & Annual Reviews

Many PGA Professionals have a dim view of performance reviews and either dread them or avoid them completely. I would challenge you (whether you are the employer or the employee) to understand how much value perfor-

mance reviews can provide. The benefits are two-fold and are generally overlooked by both supervisor and employee. With the end of the year approaching and many professionals being involved in performance reviews, I thought I'd offer a quick overview of why performance reviews are beneficial.

A well-designed and implemented performance review system helps both employer and employee. For the employer, it is an opportunity to discuss performance expectations, give credit and thanks for accomplishments and where needed, offer constructive criticism. For employees, reviews provide a frank assessment of their work and how they are meeting expectations, encouragement and reinforcement for a job well done and a framework for improvement to continue to advance their career.

Employers and employees must take the initiative to get more from performance discussions. This is an ongoing process, not a chore to "get it over with" until another 12 months goes by. Think of it as a yearlong system that includes:

- I. Clear expectations and career development plans. Not handed down from above, but jointly created and negotiated.
- 2. Ongoing coaching and feedback. Though many people do dread the idea of the annual review, employee surveys across industries reveal that receiving ongoing coaching and feedback is what employees want more of most.
- 3. Annual summary of accomplishments and improvements. The year-end review is the chance to step back and look at the year as a whole. Focus on end results that were achieved. Discuss responsibility for things that didn't go as planned. Keep the focus on the future, using the past as a learning experience.

Employers assisting employees in reaching new heights of performance will ensure success in any business venture; ultimately creating a scenario where everyone is a winner!

DONATE CLUBS FOR VETERANS

PGA Best Practice in Player Development Submitted by Bob Beach, PGA



Bob Beach on the importance of donating clubs for veterans:

The New England PGA Section conducted a sixweek session of free golf clinics for veterans and disabled veterans last fall at Braintree Municipal Golf Course. We were pleasantly surprised that

six of the veterans had never played golf before. We extended the clinics an additional two weeks in order to get the beginners out on the golf course. A nonprofit called Golf For All donated full sets of golf clubs to each of our new golfers. One of our female students has a husband who is serving our country in the Coast Guard. We were having trouble finding her a set of clubs, so we contacted the New England PGA Section office. Our Section quickly sent out an email entitled "Clubs for Vets," and within a couple of days the woman had a new set of golf clubs courtesy of two Section members. Several other PGA members have also donated golf clubs. We like to have the person receiving the golf clubs write a short bio about their military service, which we publish in the Section newsletter along with a photo of them receiving their new clubs.

Bob Beach on the business impact of donating clubs for veterans:

We held 46 free clinics for veterans and disabled veterans in the New England PGA Section in 2012, and we set a goal to top that number this season and attract more veterans that are new to the game. We plan to give them a set of golf clubs whenever possible. It is a privilege to be able to help veterans in any way and thank them for their service to our country, and it is the right thing to do. I feel if we, as PGA Professionals, can also provide them a set of golf clubs and help get them started in something new, that's even better. Creating new golfers out of veterans will only help our game.
