

New England PGA Junior Tour Rules Official Position

The New England Section of the PGA (NEPGA) looking to fill <u>multiple</u> Rules Official positions for its Junior Tour from June to August. The NEPGA Junior Tour consists of more than 100 events throughout the New England Section of the PGA. The NEPGA Jr Tour has a heavy concentration of events in Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Rhode Island and Cape Cod. The NEPGA Junior Tour is open to all junior amateurs 9-21 that reside within the jurisdiction of the New England Section.

The NEPGA Rules official will assist in applying & enforcing the Rules at junior tour events while at the same time using those Rules instances as "teaching moments" for the juniors. The Rules Officials will also help facilitate pace of play and maintain that all players observe proper etiquette and regulations of the NEPGA Junior tour.

Responsibilities

It is strongly recommended and encouraged that all NEPGA officials attend a USGA Rules of Golf workshop once every three years. These workshops will allow officials to be up to date with the necessary changes in the rules of golf. In addition to the USGA Rules of Golf workshops, the USGA provides continuing education via their rules website that we suggest all officials read regularly as well as take provided self-test practice exams. Utilizing these resources will help the NEPGA to improve the service we provide to all players.

- Enforce Rules of Golf
- Facilitate Pace of Play
- Assist with tournament/event set-up
- Assist with any inclement weather decisions (when needed)
- Maintain constant communication with host facility and NEPGA Staff
- Uphold NEPGA Jr Tour regulations & maintain all players observe proper etiquette
- Other duties as assigned
- Must be able to work 7-10 events
- Availability to field Rules questions via phone

Experience / Qualifications:

- Attended 2019 Rules of Golf Workshop, preferred
- USGA Rules test scored 70 on the 100question test, or 65 on the 80question test, preferred
- Experience in Junior Golf

Additionally, candidates interested in the Rules Official position should possess the following traits & qualities. Respect for the game of golf; Interest in the Rules of Golf; Interest in giving back to the game; Interpersonal Skills; Patience; Listening Skills; Observant; Organizational Skills; a Golfer; Functional knowledge of the New England PGA.
