Since opening in 1996, the TPC Las Vegas golf course (previously TPC at The Canyons) has some of the richest PGA TOUR history in all of Las Vegas. From 1996-2006, the TPC Las Vegas hosted the Shriner's Hospitals for Children Open, the Bard Capital Challenge and the Las Vegas Senior Classic. During that time, some of the world's best golfers and major title winners — Phil Mickelson, John Daly, Hale Irwin and Jim Furyk — have graced the fairways of the TPC Las Vegas.



Southern Highlands is one of only four courses co-designed by the legendary Robert Trent Jones, Sr., and his son Robert Trent Jones, Jr. From the rugged, natural beauty of the desert, the family design team took full advantage of the 225 acres of mountainous terrain to create sweeping elevation changes, beautiful ponds and waterfalls, deep-faced bunkers and challenging, bent grass greens. Over the years, the Club has received many awards for the both the course and the clubhouse, and also offers one of the strongest caddie programs in the country
