

In an effort to recognize NEPGA Junior Tour juniors and to assist them with their higher academic goals, the New England PGA Junior Tour (Foundation) will be awarding four (4) scholarships of \$2,000 each to high school graduating seniors. Applicants must be members of the NEPGA Junior Tour for at least three years and will be attending an accredited 2 year or 4 year college or university in the fall of 2019.

This packet contains information on the 2019 NEPGA Junior Tour Scholarship. Students and parents should read the entire document before filling out the application. Below are a few key reminders:

- This application must be accompanied by the required documents
- Scholarships will be awarded in the winner's name to the university/college of attendance.

Eligibility:

- Must be a <u>current</u> NEPGA Junior Tour member (2019).
- Must have graduated High School during the spring of 2019.
- Must have been a member of NEPGA Jr Tour for 3+ years (current year can be included)
- Must be enrolled/attend an accredited 2 year or 4 year college or university in the fall of 2019.
- Must have outstanding personal character, sportsmanship, and leadership qualities.

Criteria & Required Documents:

- 1) Number of Years junior has been a member of the NEPGA Jr Tour
- 2) Letter of Recommendation
- 3) School Activities (golf/other sports/clubs etc.)
- 4) Essay of 500 words or less on the reason junior should be awarded the scholarship
- 5) Community Service (Non-Golf Activities)
- 6) GPA (Must include/attach final 2019 High School Transcript)
- 7) Copy of college/university acceptance letter

*Note: Jr. Members who are receiving collegiate athletic scholarships are ineligible for the NEPGA Jr Scholarship

The Deadline for filing is Monday, July 1, 2019
