

The Vermont PGA kicked its' Pro Am season off on Monday July 6th at The Quechee Club. The field was full and golf course conditions couldn't have been better. The Montcalm GC team led by Dustin Robolini took first place posting a very impressive 10 under par (134) in the two best ball of four (1 gross + 1net) format. There was a tie for second between the Ekwanok CC team lead by Peter Weatherby and the Taylormade Golf team led by Steve Colt. Both teams shot a very solid eight under (136). Stonebridge and Burlington rounded out the top five at seven and six under respectively.



Peter Weatherby used a strong front nine of three under par and an even par back nine to propel himself to the top of the individual professional division posting a three under 69. David Bennett was a close second posting a two under 70. Local Quechee Club professional Curt Goldsberry used a seven birdie performance to fire a one under 71 coming in third place.
