PAR 4 | HDCP 16

VIEW FROM THE TEE



NOTES FROM THE PRO:

A short par 4 up the hill, aim your tee sheet inside the tall oak tree on the right. Keep your second shot right of the flag.



HOLE 2

PAR 5 | HDCP 14

VIEW FROM THE TEE



NOTES FROM THE PRO:

Downhill par 5, the creek that separates the two fairways is reachable. On your second shot you can barely see the flag as the green sits in a punch bowl. The hole you see in the distance is the 7th green.



HOLE 3

PAR 3 | HDCP 8

VIEW FROM THE TEE



NOTES FROM THE PRO:

Long par 3, it is 210 yards to carry the bunker. Anything over the bunker will release to the green.



HOLE 4

PAR 4 | HDCP 4

VIEW FROM THE TEE



NOTES FROM THE PRO:

Dog leg left. Aim for the round oak. The hole is all about the second shot as the green slopes back to front and right to left.



HOLE 5

PAR 4 | HDCP 2

VIEW FROM THE TEE



NOTES FROM THE PRO:

The longest par 4 on the front nine. Aim your tee shot for the burms in the second fairway. There is a creek that runs across the fairway at 300 yards.



HOLE 6

PAR 4 | HDCP 12

VIEW FROM THE TEE



NOTES FROM THE PRO:

A short par 4 that is reachable. The turtle back green protects this short hole from errant shots.



HOLE 7

PAR 4 | HDCP 6

VIEW FROM THE TEE



NOTES FROM THE PRO:

Myopia is its name. Hit your tee shot up the right center. Everything on the left side of the fairway runs towards the pot bunkers and fescue. The green runs from front to back



HOLE 8

PAR 5 | HDCP 10

VIEW FROM THE TEE



NOTES FROM THE PRO:

Straight away par 5. The position of your second shot is the key to the hole. The hard sloping green from left to right will take a well struck shot off the green.



HOLE 9

PAR 3 | HDCP 18

VIEW FROM THE TEE



NOTES FROM THE PRO:

Short par 3 that plays 136 yards. Miss one of the 9 bunkers that surrounds the green and you can make an easy par.



HOLE 10

PAR 4 | HDCP 3

VIEW FROM THE TEE



NOTES FROM THE PRO:

Aim your tee shot inside the mound on the right. Fairway narrows out the longer you hit your tee shot. Second shot must clear the Taft bunker that guards the front of the green.



HOLE 11

PAR 4 | HDCP 15

VIEW FROM THE TEE



NOTES FROM THE PRO:

Hit your tee shot up the left center. Anything right of center may run down into the rough or into a pot bunker. Keep your second shot below the hole.



HOLE 12

PAR 4 | HDCP 1

VIEW FROM THE TEE



NOTES FROM THE PRO:

Long par 4. Let your driver go. A well struck tee shot will leave you a mid-iron into another turtle back green. A shot that lands short will run up to the hole.





HOLE 13

PAR 4 | HDCP 5

VIEW FROM THE TEE



NOTES FROM THE PRO:

Hit your tee shot down to the end of the fairway. Distance to the end of the fairway is 260 yards. Make sure you take enough club as any shot that lands on the front of the green will come back down the hill.



HOLE 14

PAR 4 | HDCP 11

VIEW FROM THE TEE



NOTES FROM THE PRO:

Take it down the right center of the fairway. A well placed drive will leave you a short iron into the hole. A shot that is long will find the deep bunker over the green.



HOLE 15

PAR 5 | HDCP 13

VIEW FROM THE TEE



NOTES FROM THE PRO:

Reachable par 5 with a well struck drive. Two pot bunkers guard the front of the green. Green slopes from back to front.



HOLE 16

PAR 3 | HDCP 17

VIEW FROM THE TEE



NOTES FROM THE PRO:

Downhill par 3. Green slopes from back to front. A shot that lands on the left side of the green will run into the bunker over the green



HOLE 17

PAR 4 | HDCP 9

VIEW FROM THE TEE



NOTES FROM THE PRO:

Drive it down the left center of the fairway. An errant tee shot to the right may catch the large crossing bunker on the right side. Keep your second shot to the left, a shot that comes up short will roll into the front right pot bunker.



HOLE 18

PAR 4 | HDCP 7

VIEW FROM THE TEE



NOTES FROM THE PRO:

Tough driving hole. Aim it at the second chimney from the right on the club house. If you find the fairway off the tee you will be left with a mid-iron into the green. Two large bunkers guard the front of the green.
