





NOTES FROM THE PRO:


Downhill par 5, the creek that separates the two fairways is reachable. On your second shot you can barely see the flag as the green sits in a punch bowl. The hole you see in the distance is the 7th green.












Myopia is its name. Hit your tee shot up the right center. Everything on the left side of the fairway runs towards the pot bunkers and fescue. The green runs from front to back






Short par 3 that plays 136 yards. Miss one of the 9 bunkers that surrounds the green and you can make an easy par.



Aim your tee shot inside the mound on the right. Fairway narrows out the longer you hit your tee shot. Second shot must clear the Taft bunker that guards the front of the green.



Hit your tee shot up the left center. Anything right of center may run down into the rough or into a pot bunker. Keep your second shot below the hole.






NOTES FROM THE PRO:

Hit your tee shot down to the end of the fairway. Distance to the end of the fairway is 260 yards. Make sure you take enough club as any shot that lands on the front of the green will come back down the hill.



NOTES FROM THE PRO:

Take it down the right center of the fairway. A well placed drive will leave you a short iron into the hole. A shot that is long will find the deep bunker over the green.






the left side of the green will run into the bunker over the green



NOTES FROM THE PRO:

Drive it down the left center of the fairway. An errant tee shot to the right may catch the large crossing bunker on the right side. Keep your second shot to the left, a shot that comes up short will roll into the front right pot bunker.



NOTES FROM THE PRO:

Tough driving hole. Aim it at the second chimney from the right on the club house. If you find the fairway off the tee you will be left with a mid-iron into the green. Two large bunkers guard the front of the green.
