



PGA REACH New England Scholarship Program Application Procedures & Checklist

To be considered for a PGA REACH New England Scholarship, the appropriate application must be completed in its entirety. The information supplied must be accurate and will be kept confidential by the Foundation.

All supporting documents below will need to be submitted in one PDF, except for transcripts. Please submit materials to the Section office, preferably by email to: mpackard@pgahq.com

Applications will not be processed without the following documents.

No .JPG files with required documents will be accepted.

- Resume (relevant information can include)
 - Junior golf participation (if applicable), honors, awards, extracurricular activities, and work experience should be group logically into categories, as in resume form.
- Transcript
 - Transcripts should be from the prior year Fall Semester schoolyear. Transcripts can be emailed to mpackard@pgahq.com. If transcripts need to be mailed, please mail to New England PGA Foundation, ATTN: Michael Packard, PGA P.O Box 743, Boylston, MA 01505.
- ACT and/or SAT scores (High School Applicants Only)
- Student Aid Report (SAR) and Expected Family Contribution (EFC) information
 - You will receive your SAR and EFC information when you complete your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Please note that the FAFSA is available at libraries, colleges, universities, and online at www.fafsa.edu.gov. You will receive the SAR approximately four weeks after you file your FAFSA.
- Personal Statement
 - Include a personal statement of no more than 150 words expressing how your school experiences, academics, extracurricular activities, and work experiences are shaping your educational and career goals, why you should be considered for scholarship support.
- Letter(s) of Recommendation
 - This can be from a Golf Professional, Employer, High School Coach, Teacher at your school, or anyone other than a family member who can tell us why you are especially deserving of this award.
- List of Extracurricular Activities (recommended)
