- Supervise, schedule and train golf staff as directed by the Head Golf Professional.
- Assist in the purchasing, receipt, display, inventory, control, promotion and sales of merchandise.
- Assist in managing the club repair business.
- Conduct oneself in a professional manner and maintain a professional image while at Cohasset and also when off the premises.
- Be informed on, and promote all club activities and services.
- Stay up to date on latest club technology, fitting equipment and teaching methods/technologies.
- Manage the handicap program.
- Assist in planning and budgeting for the golf operations.
- Assist in managing tournaments and outings.
- Play golf with all different segments of members from Cohasset, to include Men, Women, Seniors & Juniors.
- Represent Cohasset Golf Club in community service and Sectional/National tournaments to enhance the Golf Staff's image for Cohasset Golf Club.
- Seek and attend continuing educational opportunities in a variety of industry topics.
- Maintain extensive contact with supervisors and club management to ensure teamwork and seamless integration of all operations throughout the club.
