

MARLBOROUGH CC WELCOME

On behalf of our Board of Directors and our entire membership and staff, I'd like to welcome everyone to Marlborough Country Club for the 101st edition of the New England PGA Championship. It's truly an honor and a privilege to host such a prestigious event and made even more special by the fact that we will be co-host with a club as rich in history as Worcester Country Club.

The original nine holes at MCC (our current back nine) was designed by Wayne Stiles and opened for play in 1922. In 1969-70, Geoffrey Cornish added what is now our current front nine to provide the membership of MCC with an 18-hole layout. The course plays no longer than 6,500 yards but a set of challenging green complexes and some subtle and not so subtle elevation changes await each of the competitors.

The club was fortunate to host the Senior Tour from 1981-83 and even more fortunate to have Arnold Palmer hoist the winner's trophy in 1982 which led to a windfall of membership inquiries. Bob Goalby won the inaugural Senior tour event in 1981 and Don January won the last in 1983. Several of our current members were around as volunteers and served as hosts to some of the players. Many great stories and memories are still buzzing around the club some forty years later.

Like many other fine clubs, MCC boasts about many of its past and present members, but none are more accomplished than our very own MassGolf player of the decade, Frank Vana, Jr. Frank honed his skills here at MCC as a youngster and captured a record 13 club championships before moving on to a hall of fame career in the New England golf scene.

Our entire staff and membership look forward to providing each participant with a memorable experience and a fair test of New England golf at its finest. CHAMPIONSHIP HISTORY

The New England PGA Championship has been in existence since 1921, five years after the PGA of America and the New England Section were founded. Since that time, the championship has been contested 100 times, with this being the 101st. There have been 63 champions in the 100-year history of the event, with 21 winning the event multiple times. The Championship has been hosted or co-hosted at 59 different sites throughout New England, giving the Championship a very unique history, and a big reason why there have been so many different winners throughout the years.

The list of winners is a who's who of the best players in New England PGA history. Names from the past such as Lester Kennedy, Tex McReynolds, Bob Crowley, Charlie Volpone, Joe Carr, Tony Morosco and Dana Quigley give a glimpse of the great history of the section. Present names such as Kirk Hanefeld, Chip Johnson, Ron Philo, Troy Pare, Frank Dully, Paul Parajeckas, John Hickson and Ed Kirby litter the brass plating around the Tom Mahan, Sr. Trophy. The leaders of a new generation of New England PGA Professionals, such as four-time Wogan Player of the Year and two-time defending champion Shawn Warren, 2017 Champion Liam Friedman, and three-time Champion, two-time Wogan Player of the Year and two-time PGA of America Player of the Year Rich Berberian, give a strong indication that the talent is still strong and will be for many years to come.

This year presents another opportunity for a New England PGA Professional to join the exclusive club of NEPGA Championship Winners. Over two days in August and one in September, contested on two spectacular golf courses, we will add another name to the storied list of Champions of this prestigious event.

THE MAHAN CLUB

While the Mahan Club is nine years old, its members have close to 100 years of experience in winning the most coveted prize in New England Professional Golf. The Club, as well as the NEPGA Championship trophy, are named for Thomas Mahan, Sr., who was President of the NEPGA for more than 19 years, and served as Vice President of the PGA of America in the 1960s. This year, 181 NEPGA Professionals will compete for the Mahan Trophy.

Each year since 2011, on the Sunday night before the NEPGA Championship, past winners of the Tom Mahan, Sr. Trophy are invited to a Champions dinner. The hope is to gather the players fortunate enough to have hoisted the NEPGA Championship trophy for a few hours of camaraderie, storytelling and good-will the night before the first round of the Championship. While there are 100 years of winners, and many are not living or local anymore, the ones that are have a lifetime of wisdom and experience to share, and will get to share it with this small and exclusive group one night each year.

The Mahan Club did not initiate a new member in 2020, as Shawn Warren captured the Section Championship for the second consecutive year and third time overall (2013, 2019, 2020). After opening rounds of 69 and 68, Warren carded a final round 76 to win by five shots.

Warren will face 180 challengers who await the defending champion, looking to write their way into the history books.

CONTESTANT INFORMATION

REGISTRATION

There is no formal registration for competitors. Please report to your starting tee 10 minutes before your starting time so that our starter can go over Local Rules and any notes for play on that day.

COURSE

Rounds 1 and 2 will be played at Worcester Country Club and Marlborough Country Club, with players alternating courses after the first day. The Final Round will be played at Worcester CC.

PARKING

Parking is available for competitors, caddies and spectators. Please note that Past Champions have an assigned parking space near the locker room at Worcester Country Club. These spaces have corresponding signs, and we ask that you respect these as designated.

DRESS CODE

The following is applicable to all contestants participating in the Section Championship.

Male contestants must wear slacks anywhere on club property during Championship days.

Female contestants may wear pants or golf skirts in accordance with NEPGA Dress Code policy.

All contestants will be required to present a neat appearance, appropriate to a golf championship, in both clothing and grooming.

It is a condition of the NEPGA Section Championship that the host sites prohibit shoes with metal spikes. Penalty for breach of this condition is DISQUALIFICATION.

CONTESTANT INFORMATION

GOLF CARS AND CADDIES

Golf Cars are included in your entry fee at both Worcester CC and Marlborough CC. Players are welcomed to walk and use caddies, so long as it does not slow the pace of play. Caddies are not granted access to player dining. Push carts are allowed at both facilities.

GROUPS AND STARTING TIMES

Groups and Starting Times for Monday's and Tuesday's rounds have been emailed to all Competitors, are available on BlueGolf, and will be available Sunday afternoon through the evening at the Scoreboard. They are also located on pages 13 and 14 of this packet.

It is the player's responsibility to verify their starting time. NEPGA Officials will not call players to the starting tees. It is the player's responsibility to be in place and ready to play at his/her assigned time on the teeing ground.

LOCAL RULE: RESTRICTIONS ON PRACTICE

In this competition, the following Local Rule restricting practice before or between rounds is in effect, even if the player has completed play for the day:

Rule 5.2b is modified in this way: *A player must not practice on the competition course before or between rounds.*

Penalty for first breach: General Penalty (applied to the player's first hole)

Penalty for second breach: Disqualification

The driving range and practice green at each facility will close at 6 p.m. each day. The practice facilities at each course will open one hour prior to the first tee time each day.

The NEPGA Championship Office will be located in the Board Room of the Worcester CC Clubhouse and inside the Clubhouse behind the 18th green patio at Marlborough CC.

PLAYER CONDUCT

Any player who shall be deemed guilty of conduct unbecoming a Golf Professional while participating in the NEPGA Section Championship or activities related thereto (i.e., practice rounds, hospitality events, etc.), or who otherwise violates the Code of Ethics of The PGA of America shall be subject to fines or suspension from championship play.

The Championship Staff shall be authorized to impose penalties for any of the following violations:

- Club Throwing/Breaking
- Damage to course equipment or property
- Abuse, oral (profanity) or otherwise directed at rules officials, other competitors, spectators, Partners, Championship Staff, volunteers or others.
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages during practice rounds and/or championship rounds.
- Using cell phones or any similar cellular telecommunications equipment on the golf course during championship rounds.
- Any other conduct deemed by Championship Staff to be unbecoming a Golf Professional.

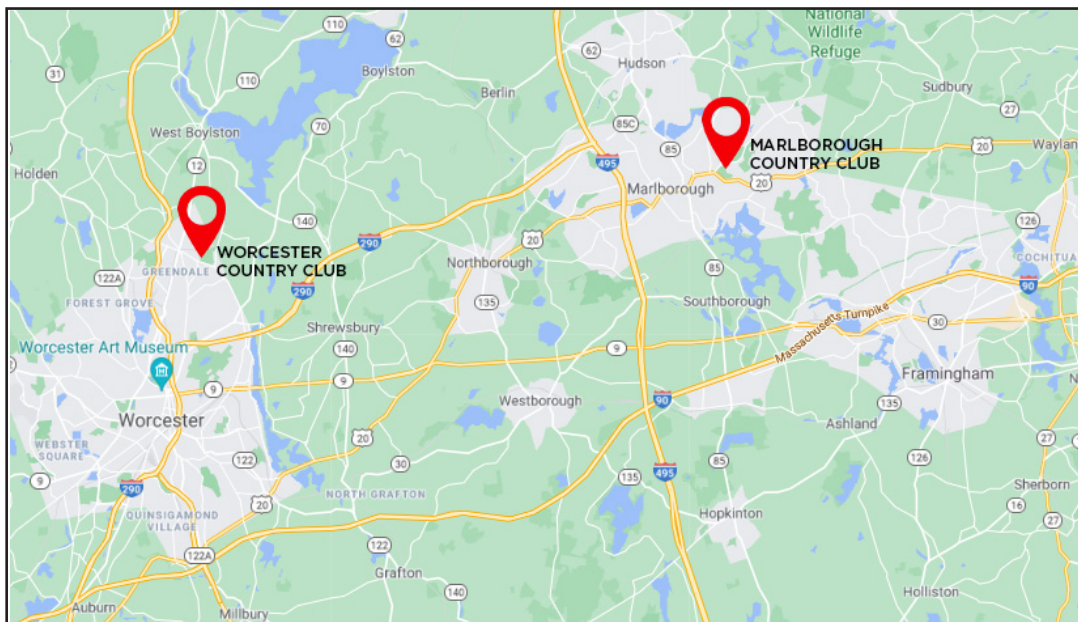

CADDIE INFORMATION AND REGULATIONS

The following practices and policies are in effect for the NEPGA Section Championship.

REGULATIONS

Caddies shall not walk on greens when checking hole locations before play, nor shall they interfere with play during practice or tournament rounds.

Caddies are only allowed on the practice putting greens to retrieve chip shots or long putts. This may only be done provided the putting green is not crowded.

Players are welcomed to walk and use caddies, so long as it does not slow the pace of play. Players choosing to ride may only have one person ride in the golf car during the round, and that person will be considered their caddie.

Caddies are not allowed in player dining. Caddies are permitted to purchase food and drink at the course for \$25.

CADDIE APPEARANCE

Caddies may wear shorts. If shorts are worn, they are to be hemmed and not more than 2" above knee length. The shorts are expected to be professional looking in appearance.

Caddies must wear smooth, rubber soled shoes. No golf spikes of any kind will be permitted.

All caddies will be required to present a neat appearance, appropriate to a professional golf tournament in both clothing and grooming.

CONDUCT

Failure of any caddie to conform to the above shall result in his/her immediate removal from Club property.

Contestants shall be responsible for the conduct and behavior of their caddies.

PLAYOFF PROCEDURES

In the event of a tie for the Championship, there will be a hole-by-hole playoff immediately following completion of play.

In the event of a tie for National PPC Qualifying spots, there will be a hole-by-hole playoff immediately following completion of play. The playoff will commence on an available area of the golf course, and will continue until all qualifying spots are determined.

STARTING TEES and SCORING AREA

GENERAL

The roped area of each 1st tee defines the teeing area.

STARTING TEE(S)

For the purposes of applying Rule 5.3a (late to the tee), a player is considered to be “on the tee” when he or she is within the roped area surrounding the tee box.

SCORING AREA

A player has left the scoring area when he or she has departed the scoring area and has crossed the roped area defining the scoring area. A competitor is considered to have returned his or her scorecard when he or she has first left the scoring area.

SUSPENSION OF PLAY

SUSPENSION OF PLAY FOR A DANGEROUS SITUATION: When play is suspended for a dangerous situation, if the players in a group are between play of two holes, they shall not resume play until the Committee has ordered a resumption of play. If they are in the process of playing a hole, ***they must discontinue play immediately*** and shall not thereafter resume play until the Committee has ordered a resumption of play.

All practice areas shall be closed during suspension for a dangerous situation until the Committee has declared them open for use.

Note: A suspension for a dangerous situation shall be signaled by one prolonged siren or horn blast. All other types of suspension shall be signaled by three intermittent siren or horn blasts. Resumption of play will be signaled by two intermittent siren or horn blasts.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF THIS LOCAL RULE: **DISQUALIFICATION**

All players must return to the clubhouse for a dangerous situation suspension.
