• Job Summary (Essential Functions)

Manage golf and golf-related activities and events.

Job Tasks (Additional Responsibilities)

1. Assists the Director of Golf with Operational plans, promotes and directs all golf activities including daily management responsibilities.
2. Manages department communications for weekly golf activity, tournament marketing and general golf communications to the club with the Director of Golf.

3. Selects, supervises, trains and evaluates golf shop, golf range, golf bag and club storage employees and on-course personnel.
4. Provides golf lessons to members and guests.
5. Organizes and conducts club tournaments and related events based on the approved club calendar.
6. Interprets and enforces golf rules and regulations.
7. Interprets and enforces club policies, rules and regulations.
8. Consults with the director of golf about golf course marking and practice facility operations, maintenance and course rules.
9. Cooperates with the golf course superintendent about maintenance issues/activities that affect the playability of the golf course for posting players on a daily basis.
10. Implements and administers a system governing the start of play and the handicap system.
11. Represents the club in area professional events including local or state events with the approval of the director of golf and chief operating officer.
12. Attends all staff, management and other applicable meetings.
13. Maintains records relating to player and guest rounds and other statistics.
14. Supervises course rangers to help ensure that expected performance is delivered.
15. Assist director of golf with scheduling staff hours to assure that members and customers are fully served and that labor costs are maintained.
16. Supervises the work of support staff.
17. Provides for the collection and issuance of all prizes associated with all competitions.
18. Performs other appropriate tasks assigned by the director of golf and COO in support of other departments throughout the year.
