

Working Foreman/Irrigation Technician, Golf

Job Description:

Supervisory and skilled manual/construction work in the care and maintenance of a municipal golf course; all other work as required. Operates and maintains automatic computerized irrigation system. Makes routine repairs and maintenance of sprinklers, valves, solenoids, coils, and field satellite controllers. Fixes leaks, installs new sprinkler heads, test and troubleshoots electrical components. Adjusts watering schedules and programs water management software. Maintains irrigation parts and supplies inventories, orders supplies as needed. Responsible for the winterization and startup of system.

Minimum Qualifications:

High School diploma with three years' experience in grounds, turf maintenance, agronomy, or horticulture, including one year supervisory experience. Valid Class D Driver's License. Valid Pesticide License.

Additional Qualifications:

Knowledge of golf course maintenance practices, tools and materials. Knowledge of operations and maintenance of irrigation systems. Knowledge of the proper use of pesticides, fungicides, herbicides and fertilizers. Knowledge of the game of golf is desirable. Ability to provide work direction and to communicate effectively. Ability to train and supervise subordinates. Ability to make informed decisions quickly and accurately. Skill in operating maintenance equipment. Proficiency in the use of computers.
